SCHOOL BUILDING

The beautiful double storied building with provision of class rooms from L.K.G to Std – X stands on its own land with lovely flower garden and a spacious play ground.

BASIC PRINCIPLES OF THE SCHOOL

In the school emphasis is being given for physical, mental and psychological development of the students curricular and co-curricular activities through continuous comprehensive evaluation systems. The motto of our school is to develop the qualities of a good human being in our students and to compete with their counter part in urban areas as well as technological age and to achieve excellence.

OUR ROLL STRENGTH

The academic session starts from 1st April 2019 and the present strength of the school is 302. After getting enormous support from the guardians we have 2 sections in nursery classes.

STAFF POSITION

A group of qualified and devoted teachers are working in the school for the academic session 2019-20. Which includes One principal, one vice-principal, 12 Assistant teachers one PET, one Office-Asst, one accountant, 2 peons, one security guard and one night watchman.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

The well equipped library with reading room is named after the late Parvati Devi. There are 6023 number of books in the library in addition to that daily odia and English news paper and journals are supplied to students in the reading rooms.

SCIENCE LABORATORY

Our school has a well furnished and well equipped science laboratory that contains all types of scientific equipments in different branches such as Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Biology. Every year National Science Day is gloriously observed in our campus on 28th Feb.

GAMES AND SPORTS

The 12th Annual Sports meet was held on 23rd December to 24th December. For this year Barsha Priyadarshani Dash of Std – VII girls unit and Dibyasundar Malik of Std – VII boys unit were declared as athletic champions of the year.

JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS VACCINATION

Our school arranged this vaccination camp on 16th Nov. 2019 which was sponsored by the Dept. of Health Govt. of Odisha. The preventive vaccine was injected to 258 students from L.K.G to Std – X.

SCHOOL RESULT

The 2nd batch of Class – X students consisting of 43 examinees appeared the Board Exam. Out of 43 students 09 students got A1(90% above), 08 students got A2(80% above) . The school Topper for the year was Lipsarani Mallik, who secured 483 mark out of 500 (97%). It is a matter of pleasure that two students, Lipsarani Mallik and Aurobinda Nayak were selected to receive the centre of excellence award for securing cent percent mark in Social Science and Mathematics respectively. Lipsarani was also the 5 star holder (from class – VI to X, she secured 90% above mark). Dr. Sarat Chandra Das Academic Excellence Award is promoted by our Director in order to create a competitive spirit among 10th Board Examinees of the school. This year this award will be received by Miss Lipsha Rani Mallik being the topper of 2019 C.B.S.E Annual examination. Our school is proud of this rare genius. 2019 year is remarkable for us in

terms of academics one of our student excelled in C.B.S.E. 10th Board Exam by securing 97% and this year C.B.S.E New Delhi has accorded approval for next 5 years to secondary courses which has been inspected by C.B.S.E.
